

Free Trash Day Tokens for Gilpin County residents.

Each residential property in Gilpin County is eligible for one free trash day token per calendar year. Tokens are intended to assist with an annual clean up, and are valid for up to 5 cubic yards of waste.

- One token per residential property is available to Gilpin County residents and property owners.
- Residents must pick up token at the Public Works office prior to bringing any loads. Residents are required to show proof of residency or property ownership.
- Resident receiving the token must be present with all Free Trash Day loads, they are not transferrable.
- Tokens for rental houses may be picked up by the landlord with proof of ownership OR by the tenant with proof of residency.
- Owners of undeveloped residential land may receive only one token to clean up their multiple lots.
- Tokens are:
 - Valid one day only of the resident's choosing during the calendar year they are issued. 2018 tokens are green;
 - Limited to 5 cubic yards. Can be multiple trips on the same day. Debris rates of \$20 per yard will be charged on portions exceeding 5 yards. Please note: Loads are measured by volume, so pack your load accordingly;
 - Valid for general clean ups, including construction debris, old furniture, mattresses and most appliances. Yard waste must be bagged;
 - For residential clean up, not commercial properties;
 - Not transferrable and are to be used to clean up the property the token is assigned to.
- Items that are **not included** in Free Trash Day, and are not free with tokens include:
 - Household garbage;
 - **Tires;**
 - TV's, computers & other **electronic waste;**
 - Concrete; asphalt;
 - Car batteries, motor oil & antifreeze.These items can be disposed of at the transfer site for a fee.
- Refrigerators, freezers are not accepted at the transfer station. See list of disposal options.

Please leave the token attached to the paper form, this will help speed up the process at the transfer station.
